## World Nursery Rhyme Week

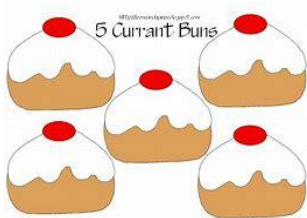
