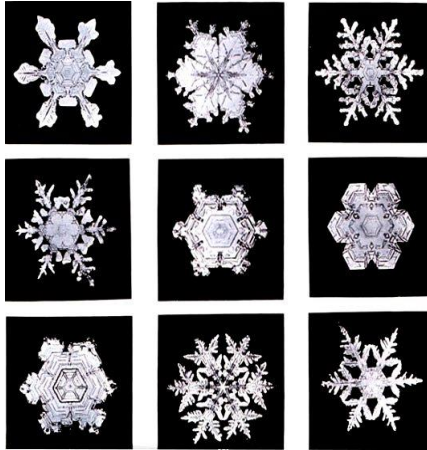
## Miss Polly
